# Duties & responsibilities:

- Monitor the implementation of the project activities at the field level using standardized monitoring and evaluation checklists to assess the overall progress of the project
- Handling the complaints and ensuring in coordination with the MEAL
  Officer/complaint officer that the complaints are followed up and resolved by the project team or the concerned staff.
- Assist in verifying and submitting the data shared from the provision sites on a daily, weekly, and monthly basis.
