Job Purpose:

Responsibilities

- Lead and conduct assessments, baseline, end-line, PDM, and other needed surveys corresponding with the project timetable
- Assist the project team in the day-to-day monitoring of the project in the overall
 implementation and management of monitoring evaluation accountability and
 information management for a high-quality innovative and effective learning project.
- Prepare complete and high-quality reports ensuring quality data from the schools are effectively tracking

- Conducting school monitoring visits and ensuring data quality and accountability processes.
- Work with the MEAL Manager in conducting education assessments as well as identifying gaps in the education project.
- Ensure implementation of project activities aligned with the plan & and BOQs
- Responsible for analyzing data and producing required MEAL reports/studies of the project: baseline, PDM, AIM & end-line reports, and VHI or donors MEAL reports.
- Supervise and provide leadership on data collection exercises, identify strengths and weaknesses in existing data collection, and raise the issue with the MEAL manager
- Provide technical support to the staff and volunteers on the use of the data collection tools
- Submit to the MEAL Manager weekly and monthly updates on MEAL activities conducted in the field
- Tracking the project performance on a monthly basis, by assessing the progress of
 the project in achieving the agreed outputs by coordinating the collection and
 analyzing the progress data against the performance indicators (through the IPTT);
 and ensuring timely compilation and reporting of data.
- Identifies and documents lessons learned, and generates best practices.
- Support and contribute to lessons learned workshops for projects to capture achievements and challenges, and record proposed recommendations for future planning
- In charge of supporting and producing successful stories on field project activities.
- Ensure the Complaint Feedback Mechanism (CFM) is functional and accessible to beneficiaries.
