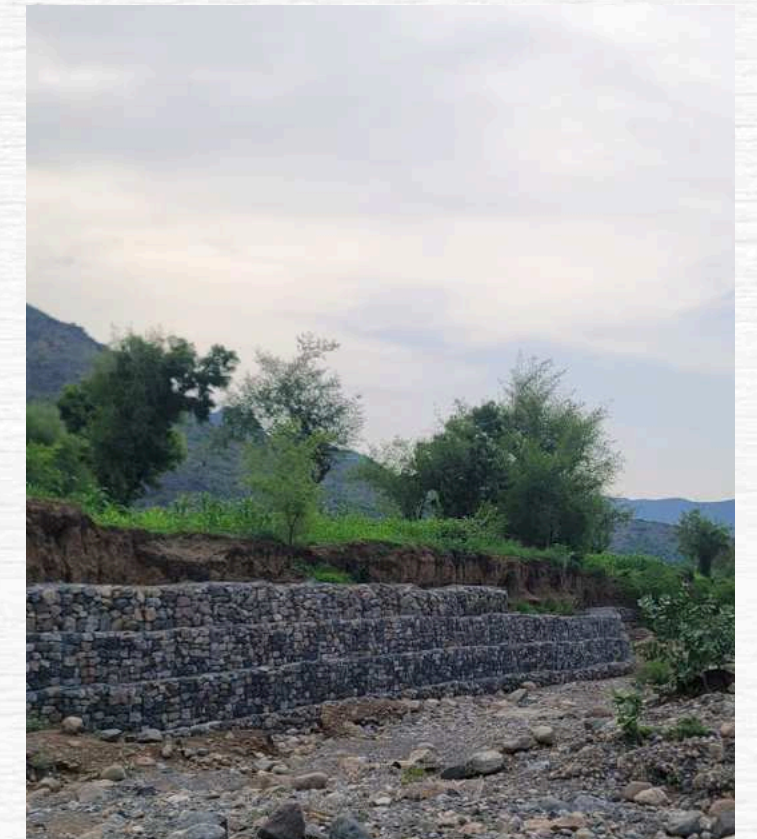

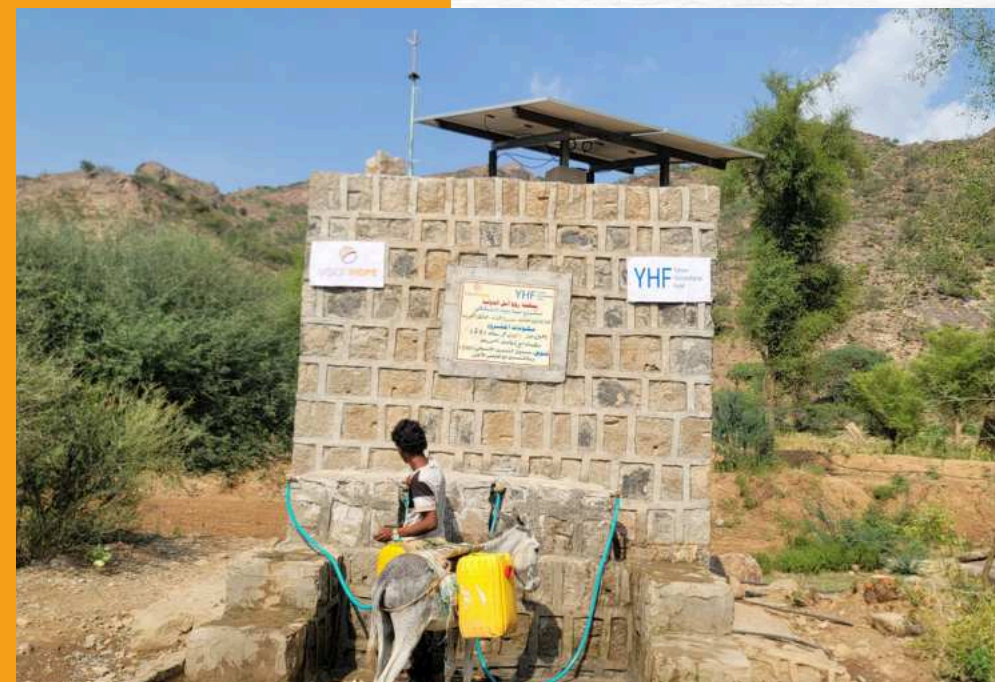

It works on protecting the village from flood erosion and safeguarding agricultural lands.





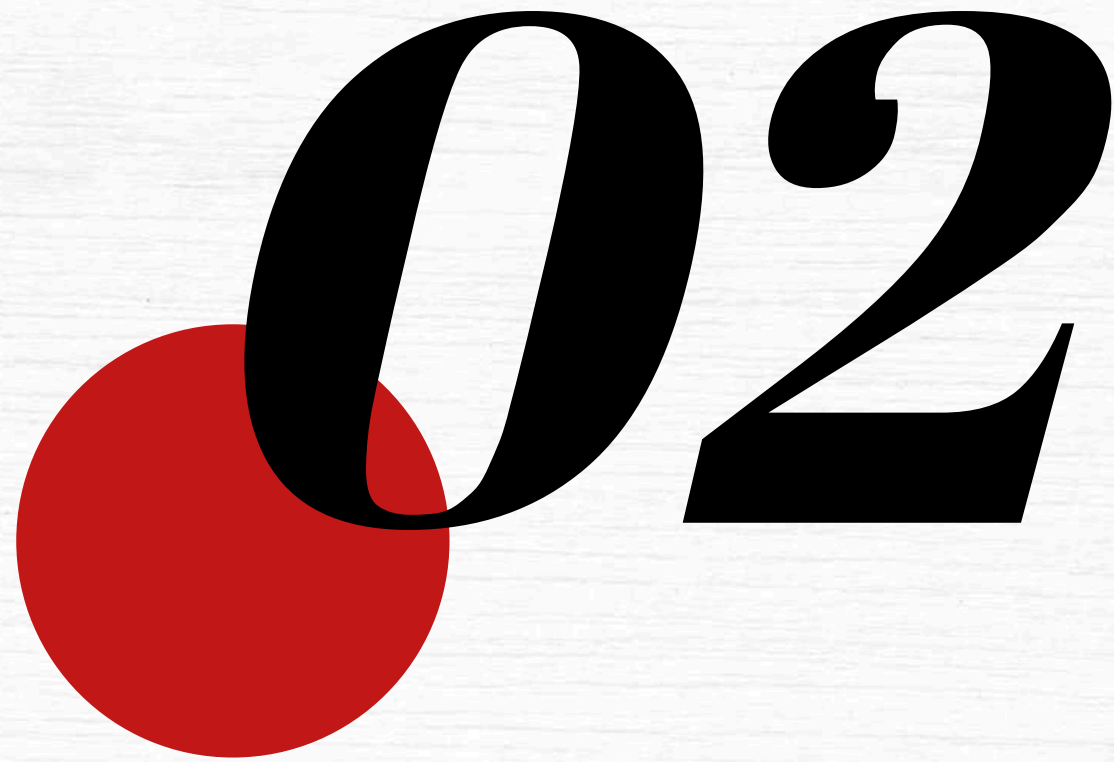
# Trainings and Micro-Business Support



Empowering individuals with diverse skills is key to building resilient communities. This initiative provided targeted training programs, equipping participants with practical knowledge to improve their livelihoods and support their families:

- Sewing and Embroidery Training: 45 female trainees.
- Livestock Farming Training: 45 trainees
- Beekeeping Training: 30 female trainees.
- Motorcycle Maintenance Training: 30 male trainees.
- Mobile Phone Repair Training: 15 male trainees.
- Agricultural Field Schools: 50 trainees (male and female).





## Education Project - 2024

Enable Gender-Responsive and Inclusive Access to Safe Learning Environments and Quality Education Services for School-Aged Children in Four Schools in Hays District, Hudaydah

- **Sector:** Education
- **Location:** Al-Hays District, Al-Hodeidah Governorate

Dhi Yazan School - Al-Saleh School - Hafsa School - Bilal Ibn Rabah School







The project successfully created a safe and inclusive educational environment that encouraged students to continue their education and supported local communities through the following interventions:

- Construction of **14** new classrooms.
- Rehabilitation of **19** classrooms to provide comfortable learning spaces.
- Construction **10** and renovating **11** bathrooms to ensure a healthy environment for students.
- Distribution of **600** school bags.
- Installation of **4** water tanks to meet clean water needs.
- Installation of **4** integrated solar systems and school radios to improve school resources and enhance the educational experience.

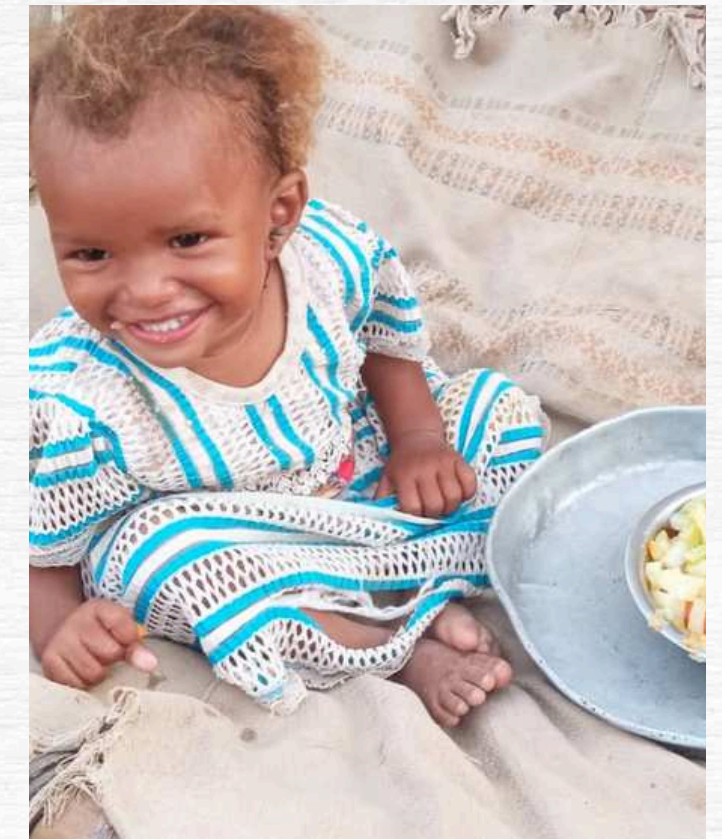

## Nutrition Project

Provision of lifesaving (Nutrition) response to IDPs and host communities in Al-Qanawis and Abs districts, Al-Hodeida and Hajjah governates

- **Sector:** Health
- **Location:** Hajjah / Hodeidah

Al-Qanawis District, three health facilities (HFs) and one mobile medical team (MMT) - Abs District, 1 health point.





During the project period, and thanks to the support provided by the Yemen Humanitarian Fund and the effective partnership with Vision Hope International, life-saving nutrition and health services were provided to **11,837** individuals. These services included:

- Improving Community-based Management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM): This targeted children aged 6 to 59 months, considering the needs of both boys and girls.
- Enhancing Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) Practices: This aimed at caregivers of children aged 0 to 23 months to ensure healthy nutrition.

The beneficiaries of this project included:

- **9,139** women
- **1,253** boys
- **1,429** girls

Al-Nahda School - Hawa'a Village

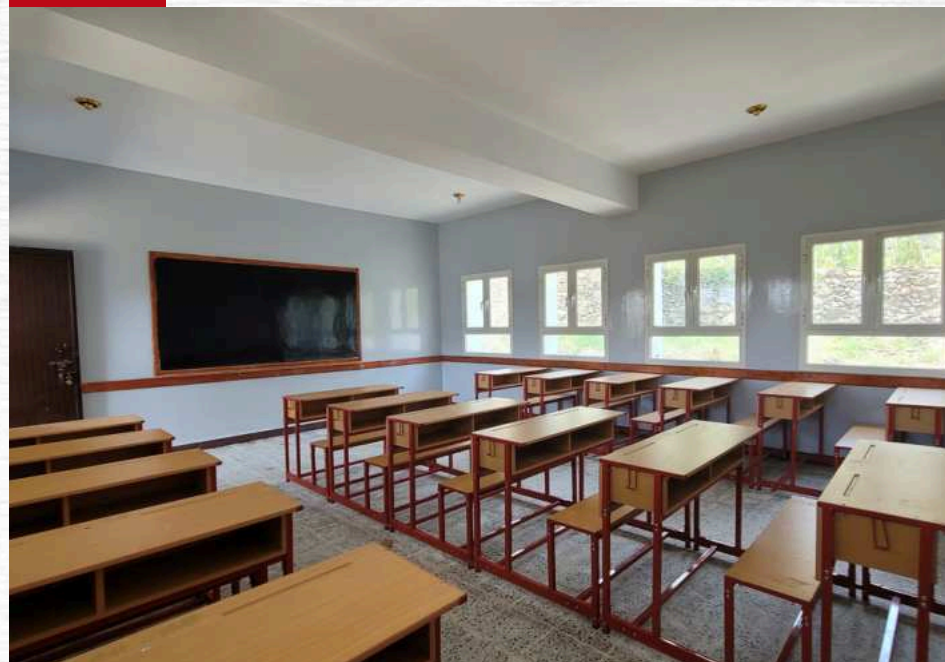






The project successfully addressed the challenges hindering children from accessing quality education by enhancing educational infrastructure and providing essential tools. As a result, students are now able to learn in a safe and supportive environment, fostering improved access to education in the targeted schools.

- Construction of **10** new classrooms and **6** new bathrooms.
- Rehabilitation of **10** classrooms and **6** bathrooms to improve infrastructure.
- Distribution of **649** school bags to provide students with essential educational tools.
- Furnishing the school with **162** double desks to meet students' needs.
- Distribution of **3** complete school systems with solar energy to encourage school activities and enhance learning.
