A Recap on the Year 2025

We look back on the year **2025** with gratitude. Our **15 projects** reached a total of **796,248 people** and brought about tangible change, such as:

- **11,620 students** are benefiting from renovated schools and improved learning conditions.
- **492,443 people** now have access to functioning healthcare facilities.
- **285,368 people** gained access to clean drinking water.
- **352 women** received targeted training to start their own small businesses and achieve financial independence.
- **570 kWp of solar energy** was installed to reliably supply schools, wells, and health facilities with electricity.
